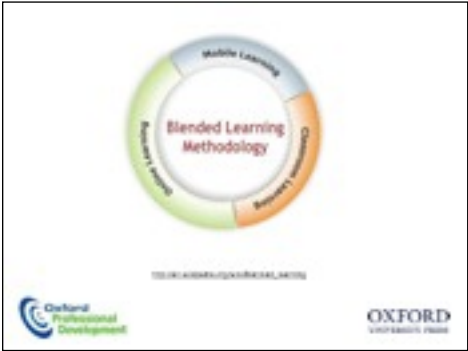

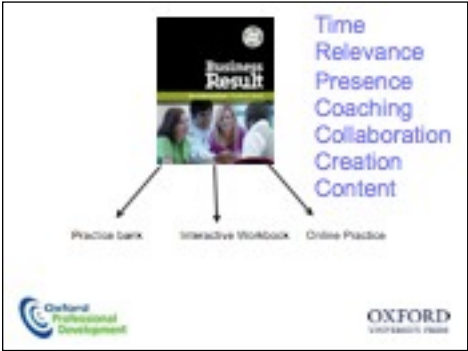

4. It's not the program it's what you do with it.

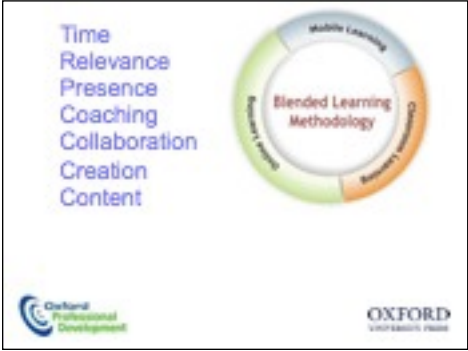


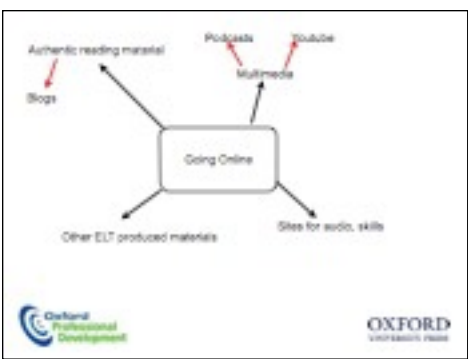

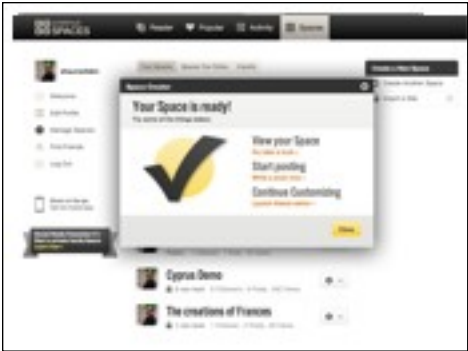
